The mission of the Traveling **Storytime** program is to promote early literacy by presenting themed story times that include books, flannel board stories and fingerplays to children ranging in age from birth to five years. This winter we distributed 1,300 copies of Penguins, Penguins, Everywhere! by Bob Barner, funded by the Friends of the Redwood City Public Library. It is amazing to witness the joy on the volunteers' faces as they present the book, the look of excitement on the children's faces when they realize that they get to keep the book and the gratitude from the caregivers' who know what a positive difference a book in the home can make on

the future literacy of the children in their care.

The Traveling Storytime volunteers picked up their books at a workshop where they made penguin flannel board sets and received penguin finger puppets to enhance their book distribution presentations.

This year, the Friends have expanded their support of the Traveling Storytime program by funding the purchase of an additional book, <u>One Rainy Day</u> by Tammi Salzano which will be given to the children in the spring.
